## Overview

### Pennsylvania Builders Exchange (PBX)

The PBX is a trade association that has been serving the commercial construction industry since 1886.

PBX is a full-service online construction news service supplying the most accurate information about construction opportunities from the design phase through contract awards. Their website includes continuously updated project news, bid documents, addenda, reprographic services, online take-off tools, sophisticated searching, tracking and notification features.

### American Subcontractors Association of Central Pennsylvania (ASACP)

ASA of Central Pennsylvania (ASACP), incorporated in 1969, is a non-profit trade association representing subcontractors, specialty trade contractors and suppliers of goods and services in 31 counties throughout Central Pennsylvania and the Lehigh Valley.

ASA is the ONLY organization dedicated exclusively to the business issues affecting subcontractors, who perform more than 85% of the work on all commercial construction, in both the public and private sectors.

### Keystone Contractors Association (KCA)

## PAK AWARD CATEGORIES

### PROJECT OF THE YEAR

There are three (3) PAK Award Categories:

- Less than \$5 million
- \$5 million - \$25 million
- More than \$25 million

Categories are based upon total project cost including both labor and materials.

One winner per Award Category will be chosen based upon eligibility and judging criteria.



## ELIGIBILITY

- The project/scope of work must have been completed within Pennsylvania
- The project/scope of work must have been completed between January 1, 2017 and December 31, 2019
- The contractor must be a current member of at least one of the following associations: the Pennsylvania Builders Exchange (PBX), the American Subcontractors Association of Central PA (ASACP) or Keystone Contractors Association (KCA).

## JUDGING CRITERIA

Judging will be based upon the following criteria:

- Collaboration/Teamwork
- Construction Quality & Craftsmanship
- Project Execution/Scale
- Safety

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## Member of the Year

This award recognizes the outstanding contributions of industry members who demonstrate exemplary support to PBX, our members, and their professional communities in Central PA. This year, one industry member will be selected to receive this prestigious award. This exemplary company must be a current Member of the PBX. The winner for the Member of the Year award must be an organization that is recognized as an industry leader. This company should exemplify service / product excellence while demonstrating business standards and ethics that possess qualities to which other business aspire.

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## Industry & Community Service Award

The construction industry is full of people who give of themselves freely to the community and others, often without the knowledge of their peers, and often without the recognition that is appropriate to their generosity. We want to honor this type of individual: someone who gives freely to the community and the construction industry. Persons being nominated for this award will have consistently demonstrated qualities of compassion, and service to either one organization or a variety of volunteer activities. The charitable activities / events or service listed on the application cannot be part of the nominee's job description or duties and the individual cannot receive any monetary or personal benefits from their involvement.

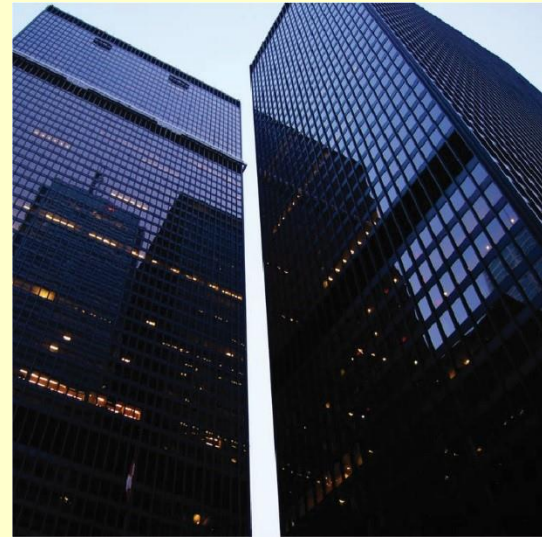
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## Safety Award

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## Subcontractor of the Year

An ASA subcontractor member who embodies the values we strive to emulate on the jobsite, for ASA and in our community.

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## General Contractor of the Year

Any general contractor who in the opinion of ASACP membership and leadership consistently conducts themselves in a manner that promotes good working relationships with subcontractors and suppliers and has consistently demonstrated a commitment to fairness in construction through project administration, efficient field supervision and fair financial practices, including prompt payment. This company does not need to be a current Industry Partner of ASACP.

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## Excellence in Safety

ASACP annually recognizes a subcontractor member who excels in their safety program. Criteria reviewed includes:

- annual EMR
- annual man-hours company worked
- designated person performing safety & health responsibilities
- company safety and health training for employees
- OSHA 10- or 30- hour training
- company safety committee
- written company safety & health program
- site inspections

Eligible members must submit a Safety Award application and their completed 2018 OSHA 300 Log.

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## Woman in Construction

The eligible candidate will be an ASACP member who has contributed to creating opportunities for other women in the construction industry and presents a positive image for women in construction.

Candidates will be judged on the following criteria:

- ASA Participation and Involvement in Women in Construction Events
- Career Accomplishments
- Community Involvement
- Educational Achievements
- Overall Commitment to Excellence

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## The Tom George Memorial Community Service Award

The Keystone Contractors Association's **Tom George Memorial Community Service Award** was created to honor the members of labor who are making a difference in their community through their actions, skills and dedication. The honorees for this award serve as a role model on the job and in the community, as they strive to improve the place they call home.

### Eligibility

A labor professional employed by a KCA construction company member

### Criteria

Individuals being nominated for this award consistently demonstrate a 'service above self' attitude that benefits the community. This award is not intended to honor labor for their efforts on the job, nor should nominees benefit monetarily for their community activities.

### Nomination

Any owner or employee of a KCA member company may nominate a labor professional. The Nominator and Nominee do not have to be employed by the same KCA member.

To be eligible for this annual award, individuals must be forty years of age or younger at the time of nomination and they must be employed by a KCA member.
