



# INDUSTRY PARTNERS COUNCIL MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

Any general contracting firm that supports and contributes to the association's educational, networking, and/or legislative goals can apply to be a member of the ASACP Industry Partners Council (IPC).

Acceptance of a general contractor's application for IPC membership:

- GC completes a membership application and submits a sample copy of subcontract
- Subcontract will remain on file with ASACP and will be available, by member request, to view prior to bidding on projects
- GC understands that acceptance of membership must be determined by the Board of Directors and the process may take several weeks; dues will be returned if Board does not approve membership
- Board of Directors receives copies of application and sample subcontract for review
- For new applicants, additional information is requested through Business Practice Interchange (BPI); only one BPI is needed, BPI is not required for renewing members
- Board members vote; approved by a two-thirds vote of Board of Directors present and voting
- Accepted application and participation in IPC does not indicate an endorsement of any specific general contractor.
- The goal of the IPC is to create a fair, balanced construction community and improve the business environment for subcontractors, and consequently, all those who play a part in the construction industry.
- New IPC members are eligible to receive a one-time rebate of \$500 from ASACP for each new subcontractor member (maximum of 3 per year) referred.
